

Flu Vaccination Clinics

This year's Flu clinic at HENFIELD Medical Centre will be very different from previous clinics you may have attended; we now need your help and support.

Please read the following details carefully:

- Appointments will be given in 2 minutes slots, thus it is essential you only turn up at your appointment time.
- If you are showing any signs of COVID-19 on the day (new continuous cough, high temperature, loss or change in smell/taste) DO NOT come to this appointment.
- Face covering are compulsory and please ensure you are wearing the correct clothing (see below)
- Please follow all instructions from our staff members, they are there for your and our protection and the smooth running of the flu clinic.
- Social distancing measures and guidelines apply please visit our website for more details.

What should I wear?

In order for our flu clinics to run as smoothly as possible please help us by wearing clothing that allows easy access to the very top of your arm as pictured here:



- If you are unable to show a staff member the top of your arm, we will ask you to rebook.
- Coats are allowed, but you will be asked to remove them when entering the clinic.

Please DO wear a: T-Shirt, vest, short sleeve shirt, sleeveless dress etc
